In 2013, 2014, & 2015 MSC has built over 400km of access roads, 16 drill pads, 450km of seismic line and rehabilitation. ranging from central Australia to the Top End.

We have supplied fully catered camps to exploration companies & drillers from central Australia to the Top End and Kimberley. ranging from 28 to 120 man capacity.

We have also constructed the "Wet Plant" and haul roads for Australian Ilmenite Resources as well as hard stands and laydown areas.

In association with an RTO we provide training up to Certificate 111 in Resource Infrastructure, Civil Construction and Pastoral.

This training is targeted at Aboriginal people who have the desire and commitment to work in he resource, exploration or pastoral industry.

The training is conducted in exactly the same way that a remote mining/exploration project would be operated so that graduates are fully equipped to go straight to work.

Being in a live-in, remote situation not only equips the trainees for future employment but removes them from the "humbug" and temptations that are the cause of most failures of "training" programs in a town or community.

We only accept training participants that are sponsored by an employer and guaranteed a job upon successfully graduating.

in 2015 Pangaea Resources sponsored 17 local Aboriginal people through a pre-employment course in Resource Infrastructure.
